Greetings Activist!

We are thrilled to announce that IUE-CWA is hosting the **How to Build an Anti-racist Union** and the newly released **Gender Justice Program** on December 7 -8, 2023, and we cordially invite you to participate in the 2-day class.

This program addresses racism, gender bias, patriarchy, and homophobia in labor throughout history and today. It also urges members to challenge their own biases and encourages community engagement to foster a more proactive movement for gender and racial justice.

Day 1 How to Build an Anti-Racist Union

The training is divided into three modules: Recognizing Implicit Bias, What Racial Difference/Bias Look like, Understanding Racism and Anti-Racism, Union Values and how do We Build Power, and Forming Human Rights Committees.

Day 2 Gender Justice Training

The training is divided into four modules: Bias, Gender in Labor, Building Power and solidarity, and Community Engagement. The Bias module is focused on identifying common gender biases that women face at work and encourages participants to examine their own biases. The Gender in Labor module presents historical case studies of gender injustice related to work and connects them to present-day issues. The Building Power & Solidarity module further explores the significance of solidarity and what it entails. Finally, the Community Engagement module highlights the necessity of solidarity that extends beyond our union and into the wider community.



Apply Now for Joe Beirne Scholarships

A pply now for college scholarships of \$4,000 each for the 2024-2025 school year, and another \$4,000 for 2025-2026. (2nd year award based on satisfactory academic record.)

Sixteen new scholarships will be awarded by CWA's Joe Beirne Scholarship Program. Eligible are CWA members, their spouses, children and grandchildren (including those of laid-off, retired or deceased members) planning for college studies.

Final deadline for applications is 11:59 p.m., EST, April 30, 2024.

Applications are easy to make online at the Foundation's website (including submission of a short original essay). Winners will be chosen in a lottery drawing.

The program honors CWA's founding president, who served for more than 30 years. Joe Beirne took great pride in the roles he played in furthering educational opportunity and working for social justice.
