Important Census Information

This is a census year. The results of the decennial census determine how \$675 billion is distributed, how seats in the House of Representatives are reapportioned and how state officials redraw the boundaries of the congressional and state legislative district of each state.

The Rochester Chapter of CBTU is participating in making sure all residents in our area are counted. We are also asking every member reach out to their friends and family to enlist people to do the groundwork. These are paid positions at the following rates:

Positions Recruiting for:

Recruiting Assistants – \$22.00/hr

Travel throughout geographic areas to visit with community-based organizations, attend promotional events and conduct other recruiting activities.

• Office Operations Supervisors – \$21.00/hr

Assist in management of office functions and day-to-day activities in one or more functional areas, including payroll, personnel, recruiting, field operations and support.

• **Clerks** – \$18.00/hr

Perform various administrative and clerical tasks to support various functional areas, including payroll, personnel, recruiting, field operations and support.

• Census Field Supervisors – \$22.00/hr

Conduct fieldwork to support and conduct on-the-job training for census takers, and/or to follow-up in situations where census takers have confronted issues such as not gaining entry to restricted areas.

Census Takers – \$20.00/hr

Work in the field. Some field positions require employees to work during the day to see addresses on buildings. Other field positions require interviewing the public, so employees must be available to work when people are usually at home such as in the evening and on weekends.
